| Bill # | Bill Author | Position | Description |
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| HB 1375 | Rep. Jeff Boatman and Sen. Dave Rader | Pro-Growth | Switches the apportionment formula for corporate income from a treble factor formula to a single sales formula. |
| HB 1522 | Rep. Lonnie Sims and Sen. David Bullard | Anti-Growth | Creates the Consumer Health Choice Empowerment Act, allowing a consumer the ability to shop for medical services out of network. |
| HB 2191 | Rep. Kevin West and Sen. Todd Gollihare | Anti-Growth | Prohibits private property from being taken or damaged by a condemning authority unless the taking or damage is necessary for a public use and with just compensation and states public purpose or public benefit of economic development, including an increase in tax base, tax revenues, employment, or general economic health, does not constitute a public use. The bill directs the court to strictly construe eminent domain statutes in favor of property owners and against condemning authority. |
| HB 2285 | Rep. Mark Lepak and Sen. Dave Rader | Pro-Growth | Modifies income tax rates and prescribing method for computations. The bill establishes a reduction of individual income tax rates. The bill modifies standard deduction amounts. |
| HB 2866 | Rep. Kevin Wallace and Sen. Bill Coleman | Pro-Growth | Permits contracts under the Oklahoma Tourism Development Act to be up to 10 years, rather than requiring that they be 10 years. The bill increases the cap on the Oklahoma Tourism Development Act to \$30 million from \$15 million. |
| HB 2998 | Rep. Toni Hasenbeck and Sen. Carrie Hicks | Anti-Growth | Increases government burden by creating the Laser Hair Removal Act, establishing standards for the practice of laser hair removal, requiring health professionals to meet certain standards and perform certain procedure. |
| HB 3252 | Rep. Mike Osburn and Sen. Kristen Thompson | Pro-Growth | Consolidates the Department of Commerce duties to be focused on community building and small business programs. A more efficient Commerce Department will decrease the government burden of some of its programs and make the department run more effectively. |

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| HB 3274 | Rep. Rhonda Baker and Sen. Adam Pugh | Pro-Growth | Expands the statewide student assessment system to include a free of charge retest of a nationally recognized college and career readiness assessment and a nationally recognized career readiness assessment that leads to a certificate or the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery. |
| HB 3276 | Rep. Rhonda Baker and Sen. Adam Pugh | Pro-Growth | Allows a swifter path to certification in a career that does not require an advanced degree if the candidate has an industry-recognized credential and experience. |
| HB 3351 | Rep. Marcus McEntire and Sen. Kristen Thompson | Pro-Growth | Creates a tax credit for medical preceptorships funded by an increase in health care licensing fees. HB 3351 supports the health workforce, which could increase access and affordability. |
| HB 3426 | Rep. Nick Archer and Sen. John Haste | Pro-Growth | Oklahoma is positioned uniquely to become, if nurtured, the leading state in the aerospace sector. HB 3426 creates tax credit for the space industry to foster that goal. |
| HB 3453 | Rep. Jeff Boatman and Sen. Todd Gollihare | Anti-Growth | Creates an artificial intelligence bill of rights requiring businesses to disclose when using AI. |
| HB 3541 | Rep. Mark Lepak and Sen. Shane Jett | Anti-Growth | Adjusts provisions of the Energy Discrimination Elimination Act to include the discrimination of agriculture, timber and mining. |
| HB 3595 | Rep. Brian Hill and Sen. Jerry Alvord | Pro-Growth | Creates an online job center under the Employment Security Commission and makes accessible a skills test. |
| HB 3597 | Rep. Brian Hill and Sen. Lonnie Paxton | Pro-Growth | Streamlines the WIOA funding so that Oklahoma Employment Security Commission is charged with developing the Work-Based Learning Programs. |
| HB 3622 | Rep. Brian Hill and Sen. Adam Pugh | Pro-Growth | Creates the Oklahoma Enterprise Task Force to report on best practices of infrastructure development. |
| HB 3670 | Rep. Nicole Miller and Sen. John Haste | Pro-Growth | Increases the civil engineering workforce by creating a tax credit for newly graduated civil engineers. Oklahoma needs more civil engineers, HB 3670 may help entice civil engineers to stay in state or move back home. |

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| HB 3694 | Rep. John George and Sen. Julie Daniels | Pro-Growth | Lowers the dollar value of stolen goods from \$500 to \$1,000 to be convicted for felony larceny. |
| HB 3781 | Rep. Collin Duel and Sen. Adam Pugh | Pro-Growth | Permits Oklahoma to join the Physician Assistants Licensure Compact, allowing reciprocity of states within the compact. |
| HB 4070 | Rep. Kevin Wallace and Sen. Chuck Hall | Pro-Growth | The Rural County Economic Development Act allows county commissioners to create an economic development organization to compete for projects coming into the state. |
| HB 4072 | Rep. Kevin Wallace and Sen. John Haste | Pro-Growth | Allows employees who change employers under the aerospace tax credit to remain eligible for the tax credit at the new employer. |
| HB 4147 | Rep. Suzanne Schreiber and Sen. Adam Pugh | Pro-Growth | Addresses both sides of the childcare issue by Creating a tax credit for employers who offer benefits to their employee. |
| SB 11 | Sen. Dave Rader and Rep. Daniel Pae | Pro-Growth | Removes the prohibition on a person incarcerated in a state, federal or private correctional facility receiving a state tuition aid grant. |
| SB 119 | Sen. Micheal Bergstrom and Rep. Mark Lepak | Pro-Growth | Creates the Right-to-Start Act. It creates the Office of Entrepreneurship in the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to oversee programs and policies supporting the growth of entrepreneurship in the state. |
| SB 394 | Sen. Bill Coleman and Rep. Kevin Wallace | Pro-Growth | Modifies the annual limit on the sales tax credit afforded under the Oklahoma Tourism Development Act. |
| SB 531 | Sen. Adam Pugh and Rep. Nicole Miller | Pro-Growth | Creates the Rewarding Student Outcomes Act, to build an outcomes-based career, college, and military readiness incentive program for school districts, charter schools, and virtual charter schools in this state. The bill requires the Superintendent of Public Instruction to make an annual report on each district's educationally disadvantaged population. The bill requires public schools to have at least a 1 percent increase in the number of annual graduates in a cohort shown to be college, career or military ready to receive a Rewarding Student Outcomes Act bonus of \$1,500 if the annual graduate is educationally disadvantaged and \$500 if the graduate is not economically disadvantaged. 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| | | | bill requires annual reports on the program, with letter scores for each school. The bill requires climate surveys at schools. The bill describes certain credentials and tests that can be used to qualify a student as college, career or military ready. |
| SB 746 | Sen. Bill Coleman and Rep. Kyle Hilbert | Pro-Growth | Sets requirements for events in smaller communities under the Oklahoma Quality Events Incentive and events for a combination of at least two counties, towns, cities or municipalities. |
| SB 1068 | Sen. Brent Howard and Rep. Scott Fetgatter | Pro-Growth | Includes the manufacturing, compounding, processing or fabrication of materials into articles of tangible personal property according to the special order of a customer by manufacturers in the definition of manufacturing for the purpose of Oklahoma's tax code. |
| SB 1302 | Sen. Dave Rader and Rep. Anthony Moore | Pro-Growth | Allows students in DHS custody be eligible for Oklahoma Promise scholarships. |
| SB 1307 | Sen. Brenda Stanley and Rep. Anthony Moore | Pro-Growth | Allows adult learners to graduate without the required educational assessments. |
| SB 1328 | Sen. Todd Gollihare and Rep. Mark Vancuren | Pro-Growth | Allows students seeking to enter CareerTech to use the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program after meeting certain high school graduation requirements. |
| SB 1338 | Sen. Roger Thompson and Rep. Kevin Wallace | Pro-Growth | Moves the Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity funds a funds for Aerospace and Space industry development. |
| SB 1358 | Sen. Adam Pugh and Rep. Anthony Moore | Pro-Growth | Creates a Workforce Development Revolving Fund to incentivize higher education institutions to meet the state's workforce needs by producing in-demand degrees. |
| SB 1372 | Sen. John Haste and Rep. Kyle Hilbert | Pro-Growth | Creates an Aircraft Engine Testing Development Grant Program under the Dept. of Aerospace and Aeronautics to issue one-time grants to qualifying aeronautics programs. |
| SB 1391 | Sen. Cody Rogers and Rep. Kyle Hilbert | Pro-Growth | Creates a matching fund for the Arkansas River Levee Improvement to receive federal funding to make levee improvements. |

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| SB 1393 | Sen. John Haste and Rep. Nicole Miller | Pro-Growth | Creates the Long-Term Aerospace and Aeronautics Infrastructure Sustainability Revolving Fund for capital projects by the Dept. of Aerospace and Aeronautics |
| SB 1401 | Sen. Chuck Hall and Rep. Kevin Wallace | Pro-Growth | Allows unused incentive funded for infrastructure projects to be used by the company for other infrastructure projects within the same tax year. |
| SB 1428 | Sen. Jerry Alvord and Rep. Tammy Townley | Pro-Growth | Creates a rebate program until 2030 for hydrogen-based manufacturing production. To be eligible, a manufacturer must be within a municipality with 20,000 to 30,000 people. |
| SB 1447 | Sen. Kristen Thompson and Rep. Mike Osburn | Pro-Growth | Creates the Creating Oklahoma's Modern Plan for Economic Transformation and Effectiveness Act which establishes an Oklahoma Office of Economic Development, Growth and Expansion for business recruitment and development in the state. |
| SB 1490 | Sen. Adam Pugh and Rep. Nicole Miller | Pro-Growth | Allows aerospace employees to claim the aerospace industry tax credit in nonconsecutive five year period. |
| SB 1504 | Sen. Kristen Thompson and Rep. Marcus McEntire | Pro-Growth | Creates a tax created for preceptorship rotations in certain medical fields. |
| SB 1572 | Sen. Julie Daniels and Rep. Lonnie Sims | Pro-Growth | Provides certain certifications for student apprentices to licensed electrical contractors. |
| SB 1913 | Sen. Darcy Jech and Rep. Carl Newton | Anti-Growth | Requires new wind turbine to be equipped with automated lights that will only come on when a camera sense plane in the area. SB 1913 also requires companies to retro-fit existing wind turbines. |
| SJR 16 | Sen. John Haste and Rep. Terry O'Donnell | Pro-Growth | Creates Public Infrastructure Districts, allowing municipalities and counties to levy a tax for only the portion of development. |

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
